TUESDAY NIGHT SCHOOLING SHOWS

July 15 and 22 at FENCE

Some thing to know....

- ▶ **Office opens at 2:00 pm for entries.**
- ▶ All must wear safety certified helmet when mounted.
- ▶ Attire: Casual -- polo or short sleeved shirt. Half chaps are OK.
- ▶ Food: Volunteers will be fed by the Show Committee. All others can have dinner for \$4 - \$5.
- ▶ Stalls are available for "\$5 -- you clean basis" or "\$20 -- we clean basis". You must obtain a stall card from the Show Secretary before you put your horse in a stall-- and **a \$20 deposit check is required.** All horses in a stall without a stall card will be towed. When your stall is inspected you will get back your deposit check.
- ▶ Negative Coggins is required for all horses on the grounds.
- ▶ Non-showing horse on the grounds will be assessed a **\$10** grounds fee. They must check in at the show office to obtain a number. ALL horses on the grounds must have a number so that if they come flying by the show office without a rider we can find out who they belong to.
- ▶ We do paper ribbons to save costs so you can show more!

Hunter/Jumper Ring

- There will be schooling in the jump ring one hour prior to the start of the classes. Cost is \$5 per schooling round (maximum of 10 minutes in ring).
- Classes 8-37 are judged "hunter style"; Classes 38-39 are judged "jumper style".
- You are expected to ride when your class is called. There will be a 2 minute warning for the end of the class then the course will be reset and you will forfeit your fee if you have not ridden before the close of that section.
- Short Stirrup and Long Stirrup riders ride in the same section (i.e. Crossrails, 18", etc.). Tell the in-gate person what division and class you are riding in.
- 3 refusals and you are excused. Practice and come back next time.

Dressage Ring

Sign up for a time at the office until 4:15 pm, then sign in at the in-gate for a time (*hint: coming early to the office gets you the time you want!*).

Flat Classes

Classes 1-7 are geared toward beginner riders
