AWARDS

Trophy and six ribbons. Master's High Score – for entries with combined horse + rider age exceeding 55 years. High point awards JR/YR, AA, Open & Masters. USDF/Dover AA Medal. American Trakehner Assn High Point Ribbon: *proof of eligibility must accompany entry.*

ENTRIES: Each Entry Must Have Copies of All Required Documentation Attached.

Include your current LEGIBLE e-mail address on entry. Faxed entries are not complete.

Full refund if scratch is received by closing date less \$25 office fee. **No refunds after closing date or after start of competition.** This includes classes cancelled due to severe weather or other emergency conditions.

Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

Post entries will be placed on a waiting list to fill scratches. All "No Shows" that have not contacted the show office prior to first ride will be considered a scratch for the show and time slots may be filled.

Additional bedding available for purchase – pre-order on stabling form and pay with entry

Guest horses are welcome but must send in a completed entry form with a \$25 user fee plus the \$20 office fees, submit a current coggins, an pay either stabling or day parking.

Music for freestyles must be on cassette tapes or CDs provided by the competitor to announcer at least two hours prior to the start of the freestyle class.

Freestyle entries must be accompanied by a photocopy of test verifying eligibility (minimum requirement 60%+ at the highest test of declared level from a USEF show or any test of a higher level). *Test of choice – any USEF, USDF, or FEI test not offered in class list above. May be qualifying classes only if correct test is ridden. Classes will be split A, J and O as entries warrant. Please include rider status after class number.

Make checks payable to FENCE and mail with entry and negative coggins to Secretary. Full refund if scratch is received by closing date less \$20 office fee. **No refunds after closing date or after start of competition.** Post entries will be placed on a waiting list to fill scratches. Bounced check policy: \$30 fee; waitlisted until cashier's check received. Music for freestyles must be on cassette tapes or CD's provided by the competitor to announcer at least two hours prior to the start of the freestyle class.

TIMES

STABLING

302 Permanent stalls (10' x 10') with doors in shed row barns. Initial bedding only, 2 bags. Additional bedding available for purchase – pre-order on stabling form and pay with entry.

From I-26 take the first SC exit #1 (Landrum Hwy 14). Go 1.4 mile; turn right on Bomar Ave. Turn right on Prince Rd, go 1.5 miles and just prior to the interstate bridge turn left on Hunting Country Rd. Go 1 mile. Turn left into Equestrian facility after crossing narrow creek bridge.

ARENAS

Two irrigated 20 x 60 arenas and two covered 20x 60 arenas and two warm –up areas with all-weather footing. Lunging is allowed in warm-up areas before and after the show only, otherwise lunging rings are located at each barn.

HOSPITALITY

“Feeding Stall Concession” food available on the grounds during the day.

OTHER

Entries are limited on a first come – first served basis. Management reserves the right to add or divide classes, add or substitute judges, or make any changes required by circumstances. All dogs must be leashed at all times. All riders must wear a helmet when mounted.

** USDF/Dover AA Medal – Rider must 1. be a current USDF group, participating, or intercollegiate/interscholastic member as of the show date. 2. be showing at Second Level. 3. be an amateur in accordance with Article GR808 of the USEF rules and be registered with USEF as an adult amateur as of the show date.
