



## RULES AND REGULATIONS

Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2)exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

The Horse Show Management reserves the right to limit entries in any class, section or division, to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel award prizes, without any claim for damages; to change any course, to add a dotted line, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes, after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate judges; to change specifications in jumper classes as competition warrants. Every horse entered herein for competition will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but the Show Management will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the horse show and the officials, employees, directors, officers, sponsoring entities of the horse show and the facilities at which the horse show is held blameless for any loss or accident to his horse(s), employee(s), or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or other cause. Each horse entered for competition will be assessed a USEF Federation Fee of \$17 (\$7 Drug and Medication/\$8 USEF/\$2 USHJA) which will be forwarded to the USEF.

While every effort has been made to avoid mistakes in this publication, the USEF, the Tryon Riding and Hunt Club and its management assume no liability to anyone for errors. Any significant errors or changes will be disclosed to competitors whose entries are accepted upon their acceptance, and otherwise in accordance with USEF rules.

#### **Entries**

- All horses entered must be named on the entry blank including horses shown only in equitation where the rider is being judged. Owners and exhibitors are responsible for all horses and fees incurred by them or their agents.
- Entry blanks will be accepted ONLY when signed by the owner, rider or handler AND trainer. They must be accompanied by a check for stabling fees. ONLY AN OPEN CHECK OR CREDIT CARD SECURES YOUR STALL RESERVATION.
- A \$25 POST ENTRY FEE will be charged once the show has begun.
- All non-showing horses are required to have a signed entry blank in the office, \$100 non-showing fee, and a stall per horse for each show.
- A negative Coggins test certificate dated within 1 year is required for admittance to the grounds.

#### **Entry Closing Dates:**

**Non-Negotiable Checks:** Checks returned by the bank for any reason will be assessed a penalty of \$50 or 10% of the check amount, whichever is greater. Upon notification of a returned check, accounts will be given three (3) days to make full payment, including the penalty, which must be paid in certified funds, cashier's check or money order. Overnight mail service is advised in order to avoid notification of the sanctioning organizations for disciplinary action.

**Prize Money:** Prize money will only be awarded to the recipient of record on the entry blank provided there is valid Social Security number or Federal ID number and corresponding name and address. Prize money will be printed at the conclusion of the event. Prize money checks will be mailed within 30 days of the conclusion of the event and must be cashed within 60 days. Please confirm information on entry form is correct to insure prompt and accurate delivery of prize money.

**Stabling:** There are only 302 permanent stalls of wood construction,  $10^{\circ} \times 10^{\circ}$  with doors, available. The cost of stalls will be \$185 for the show. After Closing Date stalls are \$200. ONE ANIMAL PER STALL. NO SHARING OF STALLS ALLOWED.

Stalls will be available at 8:00 a.m. on June 7th/July 5th/July 13th. If you plan to arrive earlier you MUST call ahead so that arrangements can be made. Early arrival cost is \$15 per day per stall. Please call 800-438-3681 or 828-859-6109 for reservations.

A grounds fee of \$50 per horse will be charged to all day shippers, whether showing or not. A special parking area will be designated and all day shippers must check in at the show office immediately upon arrival on the show grounds.

Shavings orders may be placed in the show office only by noon each day.

**Refunds:** No Nominating Fees will be refunded. Cancellation prior to closing entitles a full refund. After closing date, ALL refunds are subject to a \$50 charge plus any fees owed and will only be given with show veterinarian's certificate.

**Credentials:** NO NUMBERS WILL BE RELEASED UNTIL PROPER CREDENTIALS AND ALL SIGNATURES ARE IN ORDER. All exhibitors must have their current membership cards with them or a copy thereof, or send a copy of their card with their entry blank.

All exhibitors in the Pony and Junior Hunter sections must present their measurement cards at the office before numbers will be released. All Pony and Junior Hunters who do not possess a current measurement card will be measured at a time and place to be announced. PLEASE INCLUDE COPIES OF MEASUREMENT CARDS WITH ENTRIES TO FACILITATE PROCESSING.

All exhibitors in Amateur sections must present their amateur certification at the office before numbers will be released. PLEASE INCLUDE COPIES OF AMATEUR CARDS WITH ENTRIES TO FACILITATE PROCESSING.

Rings/Footing: All rings and warm-up areas are on all weather footing

Ring A: 152' x 277'

Ring B: 130' x 300'

Covered Ring: 150' x 287'

**Lunging:** No lunging allowed in show or warm-up rings. Lunging in designated areas only.

**Schooling:** Schooling areas are approximately  $100^{\circ}$  x  $200^{\circ}$  with additional open areas. All Hunters and Equitation horses will be allowed to school over fences during the times noted on each schedule. Starters have the authority to scratch riders who do not follow directions.

**Sharps:** Competition management will place sharps containers in convenient locations on grounds. Management may fine any individual up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments.



**Protective Headgear:** All exhibitors are required to wear properly fitting protective headgear when mounted on the show grounds. Additionally, all exhibitors must wear properly fitting protective headgear with the harness secured and properly fitted while riding in the designated schooling and exercise areas, the show ring and while jumping anywhere on the show grounds. All riders must wear ASTM/SEI approved helmets while jumping on competition grounds and in hunter, hunter seat equitation and jumper classes where jumping is required. It is the responsibility of the rider, the parent/guardian or trainer of the junior exhibitor to confirm headgear worn complies with appropriate safety standards, is properly fitted and in good condition. See USEF GR 318.

**Minor Exhibitors:** Parent(s) or guardian(s) of minor exhibitors shall hold the Horse Show Management and the Facility harmless for any injury to such minor. No child's entry will be accepted or number issued unless entry is signed by a parent or LEGAL guardian. The signature of unrelated persons WILL NOT be accepted.

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

**Motorized Vehicles/Golf Carts:** Under North Carolina State Laws and USEF rules, unlicensed drivers are not permitted to operate any motorized vehicles — ATVs, motorcycles, golf carts, etc., on the show grounds. Failure to abide by these regulations will subject the exhibitor to suspension from the horse show. See USEF GR 301.

**RV/Camper Spaces:** Water and electric hookups are available. CONTAINED CAMPERS MUST BE IN DESIGNATED AREAS. Camper fee of \$200 is assessed; this includes trailers with living quarters which are connected to any electric or water service on the grounds.

**Show Ground Rules:** Dogs must be leashed and under control or \$50 will be assessed the owner and dog may be impounded by Polk County Animal Control.

#### **General Information:**

- Discourtesy to an official by any owner, rider, trainer or groom will disqualify any horses with which they are associated and fees for horses forfeited.
- Any division that is split because of age, size, etc. may be combined if there are less than 8 entries per section. Prize money will not be combined
- In all rated Hunter Divisions all classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted in the prize list.
- Helmets must ALWAYS be worn when mounted.
- Concession stand will be open each day until close of show. Exhibitors responsible for charges incurred.
- NO horses/ponies allowed on track for any reason except to cross from stabling areas to show rings where necessary.
- Parking in designated areas only. All others will be towed at owner's expense.
- Farrier on grounds, across from show office, each day from 6:30 a.m. until sunset.
- ALL shavings orders should be placed in the Horse Show Office and not with those delivering your order. Orders to be placed by noon each day thru Saturday.

2011 Zone 3 Specifications (DE, Washington DC, MD, NC, VA, WV) In accordance with GR 1111.4: Contiguous states are: GA, KY, NJ, OH, PA, SC, TN.

Adult Amateur Hunter: To be ridden by an Amateur in possession of a valid Amateur Card. A rider in the Adult Amateur Division is not eligible to compete in any class where fence heights exceed 3'3" with the exception of the Children's/Adult Jumpers and the *USHJA National Hunter Classic*. Course shall consist of no less than eight fences. Fence height shall be 3'; spreads not to exceed height of fence. Riders who compete in the 3'3" Amateur Owner Hunter classes must show a horse they own in Adult Amateur Hunter classes if they compete in both at the same show. If the Adult Amateur is split two ways it must be split from 18 to 35 and from 36 and over. To be judged on performance, manners, way of going and soundness. Suitability as an Adult Amateur Hunter to be stressed. Horses to be jogged in accordance with HU132.

**Children's Hunter Horse 14 & Under:** Open to horses only. To be shown by Junior Exhibitors, 14 years of age and under. A rider in the Children's Hunter Division is not eligible to compete in classes where fences exceed 3'3", except age group Equitation, Medal classes, Children's/Adult Jumper and Pony Jumper Classes and the *USHJA National Hunter Classic. Course* shall consist of no less than eight fences. Fence height shall be 3'; spreads not to exceed fence height. To be judged on performance, manners, way of going and soundness. Suitability as a Children's Hunter to be stressed. Horses to be jogged in accordance with HU 132.

**Children's Hunter Horse 15-17:** Open to horses only. To be shown by Junior Exhibitors, 15-17 years of age. A rider in the Children's Hunter Division is not eligible to compete in classes where fences exceed 3'3", except age group Equitation, Medal classes, Children's/Adult Jumper, Pony Jumper Classes and the *USHJA National Hunter Classic*. Course shall consist of no less than eight fences. Fence height shall be 3'; spreads not to exceed fence height. To be judged on performance, manners, way of going and soundness. Suitability as a Children's Hunter to be stressed. Horses to be jogged in accordance with HU 132.

**Children's Hunter Pony – Small & Medium - not to exceed 13.2 hands:** Open to ponies not showing in a rated division, ridden by a rider not showing over fences exceeding 3' at that show. To be judged on performance and soundness. Small and medium ponies to jump 2'. Ponies to be jogged in accordance with HU 132.

**Children's Hunter Pony – Large – over 13.2 hands, not to exceed 14.2 hands:** Open to all ponies not showing in a rated division, ridden by a rider not showing over fences exceeding 3' at that show. To be judged on performance and soundness. Large ponies to jump 2'6". Ponies to be jogged in accordance with HU 132.

**Children's/Adult Jumpers:** Open to Juniors and Adults holding a USEF Amateur Card. Riders in this division are not eligible to show in any other jumper classes where fence height exceeds 1.15m (3'9") except equitation or Pony Jumper classes. Fence heights to be set at 1.05m (3'5") to 1.10 m (3'7") however the highest money class or Classic may be offered at 1.15m (3'9").

**Pre-Green Hunter:** A Pre-Green hunter is a horse in his 1st or 2nd year of showing over fences 3' or higher at Regular Member Competitions or Combined Training Events. A 1st year horse must jump 3' and a 2nd year horse must jump 3'3". A horse cannot show in the Green Hunter Division or show over fences 3'6" or higher and still be eligible for Pre-Green. Reinstatement rules are the same as for Green Hunters. If a horse has been reinstated from 1st year green, it must show as a 2nd year pre-green horse. (Exception: Horses that have shown over 3' as a Three Year-Old are eligible as 1st year pre-green the following year that they show.) This section will receive C-rated points. Zone awards will be presented annually in each section.







**Hunter Over Fences:** To be shown over approximately eight fences at the required height. To be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted.

**Hunter Under Saddle:** To be shown at a walk, trot and canter. Light contact with the horse's mouth is required. May be asked to hand gallop at the discretion of the judge but no more than eight to gallop at one time. Martingales not permitted. Green and non-rated hunter sections will not be asked to gallop.

**Model Class:** To be shown at a walk and trot on the line; to be judged on conformation, way of moving and soundness.

**Hunter Champion And Reserve Champion:** To be awarded to two of the four horses scoring the most points over fences, in addition, only these will receive full points for ribbons won under saddle and half points for ribbons won in the model. Full points for Regular Conformation Model.

**Courses:** Hunter courses will simulate fences found in the hunting field such as brush, wall, in-and-out, oxer, post and rails, gate, aiken, bank, coop, and panels. Management reserves the right to adjust fence heights or spreads as competition warrants.


