

USEA Cross Country Schooling Day At FENCE

Cross Country Course & Water Complex* will be open for XC Schooling

Sunday, July 20, 2008**

Registration from 8:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m.

(XC Course will be cleared at 5:00 p.m.!)

FEES:

*Groups wanting to school the New Water Complex must call FENCE at 828-859-9021 and reserve a time in advance. Groups of 2 will be combined, no more than five in one group. Each group will have 30 minutes to school. Once you have received a time please make sure you are on time. Schooling Fee: \$30, USEA non-member fee is additional \$10.

ENTRIES:

All entries, fees, and release forms will be taken upon arrival at the FENCE Trail Shelter (on right, just inside the main entrance to FENCE at 3381 Hunting Country Road).

STABLING:

Stalls are available on Saturday for \$15.00/stall. You provide your own shavings. Please call FENCE at 828-859-9021 to reserve a stall.

RULES:

- 1. USEA RELEASE FORM (enclosed) must be signed by rider, or by parent or legal guardian, if rider is a minor. If participant is under 18, RELEASE must be signed by parent or legal guardian, NOT trainer or instructor.

 Those without proper signature will not be allowed to ride.
- 2. Rider must bring **current USEA number** or pay a non-member fee!
- 3. **Negative Coggins** on participating horse (within one year) is required.
- 4. Rider must be accompanied by an instructor/coach. Instructor may ride. Groups ok..
- 5. **Approved helmets MUST be worn** when mounted. The wearing of medical armbands is highly recommended and are available for purchase on site for \$8.00 each.
- 6. **USEA safety and cruelty rules apply**. Violators will be asked to leave the grounds.

PARKING:

Participants can park in the FETA parking field. Overflow parking will be at the Show Grounds.

WATER:

Nearest water at FENCE Center flagpole or at the Show Barns. Please bring your own equine and people refreshments.
