1) ENTRIES: Entry fee includes a \$25 non-refundable office fee.

Refunds: Before CD-Less \$25 non-refundable office fee; After CD- Entry/Stabling- Less \$25 **ONLY** if place filled from waiting list.
Competition Cancellation-No refund.

Withdrawals must be in writing, emailed or faxed.

Any changes after CD=\$15.

No changes after Aug 28.

Negative Coggins current through Aug 31, 2008 must accompany entry.

2) TENTATIVE TIME SCHEDULE:

Fri: Cross-country course open-3pm.

Sat: Dressage-7:30am; Show Jumping-9:00am; Cross-Country-9:30am.

3) AWARDS: Trophy & 8 ribbons. Mounted awards after completion of each division.

4) STARTING TIMES: Available Aug. 28. Times will be emailed and posted on website.

5) STABLING/VETERINARIAN: 300 perm. stalls w/doors on grounds. \$30/stall from noon on Fri.to 6pm Sat. \$20/additional night.

Grounds fee for non-showing horse, \$10. No portable stalls allowed. NO initial bedding provided. **Pre-order bedding entry form** (\$6/bag).

Extra bedding not available from office. *Veterinarian:* on call, # posted with Secretary and on Scoreboard.

6) ACCOMMODATIONS: Days Inn-5 mi., (828) 894-3303. Comfort Inn-15mi (864) 576-2992. Melrose Inn-5 mi (828)859-7014.

Camping: Limited hookups on grounds (14) - \$50/weekend (**send separate check**).

7) DIRECTIONS: Address: 3381 Hunting Country Rd, Tryon, NC 28782.

From I-26: Exit Landrum SC(#1). Hwy 14 towards Landrum for 1.5mi.; Right on Bomar; One block, turn right on Prince Rd. Go 1.7mi to left on Hunting Country Rd just **before** crossing I-26. Stabling on Left 8/10mi. Competition at Foothills Equestrian Nature Center. All turns marked by FENCE signs.

8) DRESSAGE: *Test & arena sizes:* T-2006 USEF Training Test A-Sm. N-2006 USEF Novice Test A-Sm. **BN**-2006 USEF Beginner Novice Test A-Sm. Hopeful-2007 USDF Intro Test B. *Arenas:* Sand

9) CROSS-COUNTRY: T-2200m @ 420 mpm. N-1800m @ 350 mpm. **BN**-1500m @ 350 mpm, max fence height 2'7". Hopeful-1500m@250 mpm, max fence height 2'1". *Terrain:* Hilly, fields. **All courses:** Average, for horses with some experience at these levels. BN includes bank and "pass through" water.

10) OTHER INFORMATION:

Cross-country course closed Aug 1

Levels may be divided/combined if entries warrant; state preferences under Eligible Section and birth date on entry form.

Food on grounds.

Dogs must be leashed.

All horses on grounds **must** be registered and **must** wear a bridle tag while on grounds.

USEF Eventing Rules apply throughout competition.
