**LEVELS:** Training- Grand Prix. All tests will be current editions.

**AWARDS** Prize (in classes of 3 or more) and six ribbons.

**ENTRIES**

**EACH ENTRY MUST HAVE COPIES OF ALL REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION ATTACHED.**

Include legible e-mail address on entry. All definitions and rules relating to this show are covered under the General Guidelines on page 3.

Full refund if scratch is received by closing date less \$20 office fee. **No refunds after closing date or after start of competition.** This includes classes cancelled due to severe weather or other emergency conditions.

Entries are limited on a first come - first served basis. Management reserves the right to add, combine or divide classes, add or substitute judges, or make any changes required by circumstances. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

**Post entries** will be placed on a waiting list to fill scratches. All No Shows that have not contacted the show office prior to first ride will be considered a scratch for the rest of the show and time slots may be filled.

**Please order extra bedding in advance - \$8 per bag.**

**Guest horses** are welcome but must send in a completed entry form with user fee plus the refundable \$20 office fee, submit a current coggins, and pay either stabling or day parking.

Music for freestyles must be on cassette tapes or CDs provided by the competitor to announcer at least two hours prior to the start of the freestyle class

**FEEs**

Make check payable to FENCE and mail with entry, negative coggins and copies of necessary membership cards to Secretary. Bounced check policy: Void entry and incur a \$30 charge. Entries placed on a waiting list until a money order, certified check or cash is received.

**TIMES:** Official times available Friday at the secretary's stand. Confirmations will be e-mailed upon receipt of entry. Riders assume responsibility for verifying correct entry information. Management not responsible for errors. Times & stabling posted on website at least one week prior to the show.

**STABLING:** 302 Permanent stalls with doors in shed row barns. Initial bedding only.

**ACCOMMODATIONS :** Days Inn, 626 West Mills St, Columbus, NC, 828-894-3303 . Many B & B inns in area.

**DIRECTIONS:** FENCE, 3381 Hunting County Road, Tryon, NC 28782

From I-26 take the first SC exit #1 (Landrum Hwy 14). Go 1.4 mile, turn right on Bomar Ave. Turn right on Prince Rd, go 1.5 miles and just prior to the interstate bridge turn left on Hunting County Rd. Go 1 mile. Turn left into Equestrian facility after crossing narrow creek bridge.

**ARENAS:** Three irrigated 20 x 60 competition arenas and two covered 20 x 60 arenas with excellent all-weather footing. Stone dust and sand warm-up areas. No one on foot is allowed in the warm-up area coaching must be done from the side.

**HOSPITALITY:** Food available on the grounds during breakfast and lunch hours.

**OTHER :** All dogs must be leashed and attached to a person or immovable object.

**Effective March 1, 2011, for dressage: Anyone mounted on a horse must wear protective headgear except those riders age 18 and over while on horses that are competing only in FEI levels and tests at the Prix St. Georges level and above (including FEI Young Rider Tests, the USEF Developing Prix St. Georges Test and the USEF Brentina Cup Test).**
